Revenue and Grants for March 2024 is 2,868.7 million, which is an increase of 20.1 percent compared to March 2023.

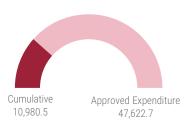
March 2024

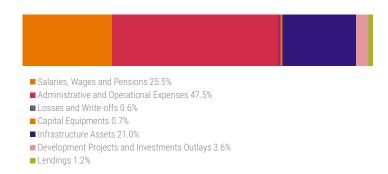
Fiscal Balance for the month of March 2024 is an overall deficit of MVR 887.0 million.

IN MILLIONS MVR



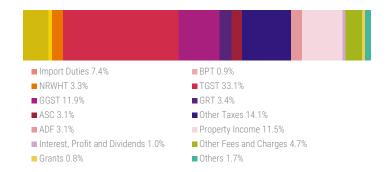
EXPENDITURE COMPOSITION - MARCH
