Additionally, could you please indicate whether the costs associated with the inspection in the country of production (flights, hotels) will be borne by the purchaser or the bidder.</p>	<p>Yes. The vessel shall be registered and certified in Maldives. All the costs associated shall be borne by the bidder.</p>
2		Section 3.1.10	<p>It is mentioned that all the required vessel drawings and documents shall be approved by an IACS Classification society. (Any Classification society under the IACS is acceptable) Upon completion of the vessel, the vessel shall be registered and certificated by the Maldives Transport Authority.</p> <p>Could you please clarify if these drawings and documents pertain to those submitted as part of the bids or if they are documents that the awarded will be required to provide after the contract is signed?</p>	<p>Yes. Or does the “service generator” refer to a separate generator to be used when the Outboard Motor are not in operation. For example, when docked for a long period of time.</p> <p>Common practice would be to charge the batteries and run the vessels electrics from the inbuilt alternator provided with the Outboard Motors. The Outboard Motors would also be electric start with their own starting batteries.</p>	<p>The bidder can propose their choice of charging the engine starting batteries and the batteries used for the electrics in the bid document.</p>
