- All waste generated from the project should be transferred to a regional waste management facility.
- Use construction practices that minimize soil disturbance, dust, and noise pollution.
- Usage of construction machinery outside of the construction area should be avoided at all costs.
- Avoid undertaking any project related activities that may generate noise during nighttime.
- Use sign boards to notify individuals that it is a construction site.
- Any excavation work shall be done after appropriately fencing the project boundary.
- If the project requires dewatering, the dewatering permit shall be obtained from the Utility Regulatory Authority prior to undertaking any dewatering activities within the plots
- Seek any additional approval required for the work from any other relevant government authority.
