Social service workers address social justice and societal concerns, facilitating positive societal change by individuals interacting with one another and providing advice and support to groups working in various socially vulnerable areas. They provide services to social work groups, community welfare agencies, social service providers, clinical practices and private individuals.

- 4. Examine the cases of children who are abused in various ways and take all necessary steps to bring the children under the custody of the state and take necessary steps to find a solution to the case.
- 5. Investigate cases of violation of child dignity, provide social security and cooperate with other relevant sectors regarding such cases.
- 6. Provide information to the courts in cases under investigation and appear before the courts and give statements.
- 7. Visit households, relevant government institutions and other places to collect information and assess the situation of children's cases and ensure that necessary measures are taken.
- 8. Prepare the "Social Situation Report" of children in accordance with the prescribed procedures and share it with the relevant institutions within the stipulated time.
- 9. Coordinate with the National Drug Agency on treatment of children who have become victims of drugs.
- 10. Take necessary steps to provide advice on how to proceed in child and family matters to those who request the service.
- 11. Investigate cases of child abuse under the Child Rights Protection Act and other related laws and provide the necessary protection to the children.
