If no, do we need to rent electricity generator or water supply facilities for the execution of the project?	The site is under improvement, nevertheless please foresee some provisional sum for water supply and electrical facilities.
2		Is the access road available at any time for the delivery of plant containers from jetty to the site?	Yes it will be.
3		Can we use the existed jetty or port, in the island of project implementation, for container unloading? How long is the distance from the jetty or port to the site?	Yes you can, the distance to the site is a couple of meters (20-25 m).

Or if not, pls consider separating the 80% amount into two stages: (i) 50% payable upon shipment of the plant and submission of the invoice and Bill of Lading; (ii) 30% payable upon delivery to the site within 45 days after receipt of invoice.
