- 13. Identify and maintain the information of students on long-term medication and those undergoing treatment for major diseases (cancer, juvenile diabetes, kidney disease, etc.) through the "Education Management Information System".

- 6. Ensure that the drinking water available to students and staff is safe; and plan and implement the school's wash programme and hygiene education programme.

- 9. Ensure the safety and security of students during experiential trips and competitions organised by the school; and make arrangements for the provision of first aid services.
