

Minimum specification of chemicals and equipment for Cleaning

Chemicals

- A registered product with a registration number
- Specified as a hospital graded cleaning and disinfectant solution
- Product label should have
 - the proper chemical name and ingredients
 - Label specifying its effectiveness against specific infectious organisms
 - Any Possible harmful effects
 - How to use chemical safely
- Safety Data sheet available for the product
- Should be a neutral detergent solutions (pH between 6 and 8)
- manufacturer's instructions, including the required contact times for disinfectant products and any recommended rinsing process.
- should not cause staining on surfaces
- should be friendly to metals (non-corrosive)
- Ready use with pleasant fragrance – (It should not be an overpowering/irritant smell)
- Should have excellent materials compatibility
- is non flammable
- Should be soluble in water
- Must be environment friendly

Note: the product shall be pre-approved by AEH QID before using.

Equipment's

- 1- Two bucket system should be used for cleaning
- 2- For cleaning brush should not be used instead of brush should use DRY microfiber mops.

Note: If any electrical or mechanical equipment's are to be used should get pre-approval from hospital before using.
